

**Geoff Hadfield**

Geoff Hadfield is the Managing Director of Hadfield Wood Recyclers and UK Wood Recycling, and a founder and former Chairman of the Wood Recyclers' Association.

Geoff has been an influential figure in the wood recycling industry for more than 38 years, having founded Hadfield Wood Recyclers in 1980.

His background is in farming and agriculture and he has grown his business from a small waste disposal company on the family farm in Manchester, to one of the UK's biggest wood recycling companies.

During his time with the WRA, Geoff has been heavily involved in advising on strategies to deal with a number of major issues affecting the waste wood sector, including most recently those of FPPs and the Waste Wood Classification project.

Hadfield was acquired by waste resource and recovery specialists Enva in December, but Geoff remains at the helm of the day-to-day running of the waste wood business and is committed to continuing his support of the industry through his role on the WRA Board.
